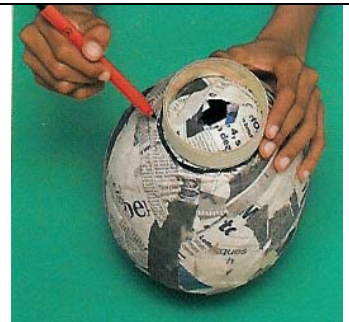
You will need: a balloon, bowl, white glue, water, and newspaper, two rolls of masking tape, black pen, scissors, sheet of 16.5 x 12 in card stock, pencil, paintbrush, black and cream paint.



1. Blow up the balloon. Cover it with two layers of papier mâché (paper soaked in on part glue, two parts water). Set aside on one side to dry.



2. Using a roll of masking tape as a guide draw and cut out two holes at the top and bottom of the balloon. Throw away the burst balloon. (When bursting the balloon it is best to let the air out slowly)



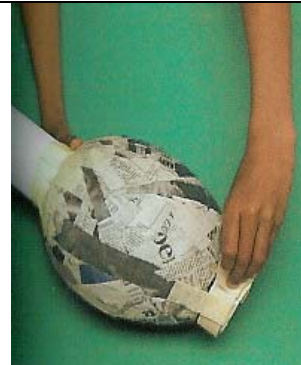

3. Roll the sheet of paper into a tube. Make sure that it will fit through the middle of the roll of masking tape. Secure with tape or glue.



4. Push the tube through the middle of the balloon. Tape into place. Push a roll of masking tape over the bottom of the paper tube and tape.



5. Tape the second roll of masking tape to the top tube. Make sure that both rolls are securely attached at either end of the paper tube.



6. Cut two strips of card stock, 6 inches long. Attach them to either side of the vase, as seen to the right. Cover the entire vase with papier mâché and let dry.



7. Using a pencil, draw a picture on each side to represent your favorite Greek story, event, person or mythological god. Carefully paint in the pattern and set aside to dry.
